**PRESENT:**

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 A.M. by Chair Carl McGookey.

**MINUTES OF THE  
PREVIOUS MEETING:**

The minutes of the May 3, 2018 meeting were approved upon a Motion by Mr. Zuilhof, seconded by Mr. Poggiali. Motion carried.

**STAFF UPDATE**

Director of Neighborhood Planning and Development Angie Byington reported that

- A. Director Aaron Kline reported that the Shoreline Drive deadline for proposals was June 5, but has been extended to the first week of July, and selection in the second week of July
- B. Nothing to report on the Neighborhood Planning Process other than bollards and green grass are to be installed at Lockwood Drive.
- C. Nothing to report on the City Hall move or the Jackson Street pier project.
- D. Bayfront Pathway, Ms. Byington passed out drawings and photographs and discussed various areas of the pathway.

A Motion to Support the project as presented and to proceed to the design phase was made by Mr. Miller, seconded by Mr. Poggiali, Motion carried.

Mrs. Corson inquired about the Pipe Street bridge and was advised that it is designed to be multi-use with pedestrian and bicycle access with adequate clearance for the boats.

Mr. Zuilhof also suggested that Edgewater Drive and the easement should be included in the Bayfront Pathway. Ms. Byington will review and report to us at the next meeting about including this in the plan.

Ms. Byington reported that the Ohio Conference on Community Development will be meeting at Castaway Bay in July. Tours will be conducted of the downtown and Sports Force.

**OLD BUSINESS**

Mr. Miller commended the City and its designers for the completion of the canoe launch and the Pavilion at Kiwanis Park.

Mr. Schwanger inquired about removal of the fence at the Keller Building.

**NEW BUSINESS**

The US Geological Survey Agency is investigating a location for their boat and office space.

Mr. Zuilhof advised that with the lake levels high and projected to raise further planning should take that into consideration.

The second Art Walk will be held tonight in Washington Park.

There being no further business to come before the Bayfront Corridor Committee, the meeting was adjourned at 8:20 A.M.
