- Go to: [2020census.gov/response-rates](https://2020census.gov/response-rates)
- Scroll down the page to view the 4 minute video on how to use the map: <https://youtu.be/r4j1o2WmHUQ>
- The interactive map is on the same page. Use the dropdown menu on the right side of the map to make selections: State, County, Cities.
- Once the desired location appears on the map, save the location for future reference. Click the share icon located just beneath the map. A small window will open. Copy the URL address or the embed code.
